- We want to break with impoverishment.
- We want to protect our pension plan against financial turbulences.
- We want to better re-conciliate family and work.
- We want to recuperate our right to negotiate.

But our mobilization is required!**

Our demands are not extravagant! Our objectives are attainable and we can conclude collective agreements by March 31, 2010. But the settlement that we want will not fall from the sky. It will have to be obtained the hard way! This is why we must take all the opportunities that come our way over the next few weeks to increase the pressure.

- **February 12th** is the moment to raise awareness among citizens who are the first recipients of the services we provide. We are at the heart of their daily lives!
- **On February 22nd**, we will be in the straightaway. The negotiation decision-making bodies of the Common Front organizations will be meeting at the same time in Quebec City. This will be an opportunity, in all workplaces, to mark the fact that time is flying by.
- **On March 20th**, we need to be as large a group as possible for the big demonstration in Montreal in order to demonstrate our will to have a settlement by March 31, 2010 to the government. A union get together not to be missed!

Your support is needed in order that those across the negotiating table from us feel your determination.

It is on our shoulders, the 475,000 government workers gathered in the SISP-CSN-FTQ Common Front, on which rest the quality of the public services that the Quebec population holds dear.
